

**Fish House Fish & Game Club**  
**Indoor Range Rules**  
**Firearms & Archery**

Failure to follow any rule may result in disciplinary action including suspension or expulsion from the club.

1. You must comply with all New York State firearm laws.
2. Shooting has hazards, use range at your own risk.
3. Possible lead hazard, exhaust fans must be used for all firearm shooting.
4. No alcohol or drugs allowed on range. No shooting when under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
5. No food or beverages allowed in range.
6. The following are allowed to be used on the range: Handguns with standard pistol ammo, .22 caliber rifles, .177 and .22 air rifles and air pistols, archery field and target points.
7. The following are not allowed to be used on the range: Shotguns, crossbows, archery hunting points.
8. Members must sign the range logbook upon entering and leaving the range.
9. Only one guest allowed per member, guest must sign logbook when entering and exiting and must exit with the member.
10. No shooter 18 or younger may use the range facilities without adult supervision.
11. If multiple shooters, appoint a "range control" officer. Range officer(s) have final say on all issues
12. Firearms and bows must be brought in unloaded.
13. Firearms to be chambered at the firing line only when ready to fire. No more than 2 firearms at a shooting station.
14. Arrows are to be only loaded at the firing line.
15. All firearms when not in use shall be unloaded, slides locked back, bolts or cylinders opened with empty chamber indicators (ECI) in place and magazines out. No one is allowed down range until these actions are taken, and the range is declared safe.
16. No firearms or bows are to be carried past the firing line, down range.
17. Only paper targets are to be used. No human like targets or silhouettes to be used.

18. Targets are to be properly positioned with backstop in shooter's line of sight. Do not position targets in front of the center support beam.
19. Use approved target holders. Do not use archery backstops for firearm targets.
20. All shooting must be from shooting stations.
21. Ear and eye protection must always be worn for firearm shooting.
22. Shoot in your lane only; no side or cross shooting allowed.
23. No cowboy shooting allowed. No quick draw shooting.
24. No holstered drawing.
25. No rapid firing is permitted. There is to be a mandatory delay. (Defined as: The time it takes to re-acquire the target at which you are shooting between fired rounds.)
26. Archers should stand to side of arrow when removing arrows from backstops/blocks, not behind. If a top and bottom target are used, top arrows are to be pulled first.
27. FHFGC rules prevail in all situations (such as shooting leagues or any competition matches).
28. Clean up and dispose of all trash in the proper receptacles.
29. Dispose of any "live rounds" in designated containers.
30. Report any damage, repairs needed or concerns as soon as possible, to any Officer or BOD member. File Incident Reports as required.
