Outdoor 120 yd Range Rules

Failure to follow any rule may result in disciplinary action including suspension or expulsion from the club.

1. You must comply with all New York State firearm laws.
2. Shooting has hazards, use range at your own risk.
3. No alcohol or drugs allowed on range. No shooting when under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
4. No steel-core, armor-piercing, tracer rounds or 50 BMG rifle or larger may be used on the range.
5. Members must sign the range logbook upon entering and leaving the range.
6. Only one guest allowed per member, guest must sign logbook when entering/leaving and must exit with the member.
7. No shooter 18 or younger may use the range facilities without adult supervision.
8. All pets should be on a leash, or secured, while shooting range is active. You must clean up after your pets.
9. No motor vehicles are allowed beyond the firing line.
10. If multiple shooters, appoint a "range control" officer. Range officer(s) have final say on all issues.
11. Ring the bell 5 times and wait 5 minutes before shooting to allow others in the area to move to safety.
12. Firearms must be brought in unloaded.
13. Firearms to be chambered at the firing line only when ready to fire. No more than 2 firearms at shooting station.
14. All firearms when not in use shall be unloaded, slides locked back, bolts or cylinders opened with empty chamber indicators (ECI) in place and magazines out. No one is allowed downrange until these actions are taken and the range is declared safe.
15. No firearms are to be carried past the firing line, down range.
16. Only paper targets are to be used. No human like targets or silhouettes to be used.
17. Use approved target stands. Target stands must be moved to the left side of the range when not in use.
18. Targets, including member provided steel, may be shot by: Pistol calibers at a minimum of 25 yards, and must be set up in front of the ground boxes. Rifles at a minimum of 50 yards, 75 yards for steel targets. No steel targets can be stationary unless they are on an 18-degree slant. Swinging and movable steel such as a dueling tree are allowed. No ground targets are to be used. Utilize appropriate gauge steel targets for your caliber.
19. Shotgun patterning on hay bales only.

20. All shooting must be from shooting stations except for shotguns being patterned on hay bales. These are to be shot from the blue barrels and not forward of the firing line.
21. Ear and eye protection must always be worn for firearm shooting.
22. Shoot in your lane only; no side or cross shooting allowed.
23. No cowboy shooting allowed. No quick draw shooting.
24. No holstered draws.
25. No rapid firing is permitted. There is to be a mandatory delay (defined as: The time it takes to re-acquire the target at which you are shooting between fired rounds.)
26. FHFGC rules prevail in all situations (such as shooting leagues or any competition matches)
27. Clean up and dispose of all trash in the proper receptacles.
28. Dispose of any "live rounds" in designated containers.
29. Report any damage, repairs needed or concerns as soon as possible, to any Officer or BOD member. File Incident Reports as required.
