

## Fish House Fish & Game Club Outdoor Archery Range Rules

Failure to follow any rule may result in disciplinary action including suspension or expulsion from the club.

1. Use range at your own risk.
2. All shooting to be done in designated areas.
3. No alcohol or drug use is allowed on the range. No shooting when under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
4. Members must sign the range logbook upon entering and leaving the range.
5. Only one guest allowed per member, guest must sign logbook when entering/leaving and must exit with the member. All guests must sign a liability waiver on their first time at the club.
6. No shooter 18 or younger may use the range facilities without adult supervision.
7. All pets should be on a leash, or secured, while shooting range is active. You must clean up after your pets.
8. No motor vehicles are allowed beyond the firing line.
9. Maximum 4 people are allowed on the tower at any time. No one is allowed on the tower when there is snow or ice.
10. Only practice "field points" are to be used on bag or 3D targets. No bladed points.
11. Hunting tips, "broadheads" or small game tips are to be used only on designated targets.
12. All shooters must follow shooting line commands and etiquette.  
Line commands:  
*Ready on the line.* All shooters are safely behind the shooting line and shooting is ready to commence.  
*All clear.* All bows and crossbows are down, and it is safe to go down range. No bows to be carried down range.
13. When shooting in groups, persons at each end of the shooting line will give *Ready on the line and All clear* commands.
14. No arrows or bolts shall be knocked until *Ready on the line* is called.
15. FHFGC rules prevail in all situations (such as shooting leagues or any competition matches)
16. Clean up and dispose of all trash in the proper receptacles.
17. Report any damage, repairs needed or concerns as soon as possible, to any Officer, BOD member or the Archery Director. File Incident Reports as required.
