Outdoor Pistol Range Rules

Failure to follow any rule may result in disciplinary action including suspension or expulsion from the club.

1. You must comply with all New York State firearm laws.
2. Shooting has hazards, use range at your own risk.
3. No alcohol or drugs allowed on range. No shooting when under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
4. Only handguns using traditional handgun ammunition, and air pistols are allowed. No shotguns or rifles to be used on the pistol range.
5. No steel-core, armor-piercing, or tracer rounds may be used on the range.
6. Members must sign the range logbook upon entering and leaving the range.
7. Only one guest allowed per member, guest must sign logbook when entering/leaving and must exit with the member.
8. No shooter 18 or younger may use the range facilities without adult supervision.
9. All pets should be on a leash, or secured, while shooting range is active. You must clean up after your pets.
10. No motor vehicles are allowed beyond the fence.
11. If multiple shooters, appoint a "range control" officer. Range officer(s) have final say on all issues
12. Ring the bell 5 times and wait 5 minutes before shooting to allow others in the area to move to safety.
13. Firearms must be brought in unloaded.
14. Firearms to be chambered at the firing line only when ready to fire. No more than 2 firearms at a shooting station.
15. All firearms when not in use shall be unloaded, slides locked back, bolts or cylinders opened with empty chamber indicators (ECI) in place and magazines out. No one is allowed downrange until these actions are taken and the range is declared safe.
16. No firearms are to be carried past the firing line, down range.
17. Only paper or club owned steel targets are allowed on the range. No human-like targets or silhouettes to be used. No moving steel targets.
18. Paper targets are to be used on the target stands. No ground targets. All paper targets may be shot at a minimum of 7 yards, unless it is an approved pistol permit class.

19. Only steel targets belonging to the club are to be used on the Pistol Range. These targets are not to be moved and/or altered from where they are positioned on the range.
20. Ear and eye protection must always be worn for firearm shooting.
21. Shoot in your lane only; no side or cross shooting allowed.
22. No cowboy shooting allowed. No quick draw shooting.
23. No holstered draws.
24. No rapid firing is allowed. There is to be a mandatory delay. (Defined as: The time it takes to re-acquire the target at which you are shooting between fired rounds.)
25. FHFGC rules prevail in all situations (such as shooting leagues or any competition matches).
26. Clean up and dispose of all trash in the proper receptacles.
27. Dispose of any "live rounds" in designated containers.
28. Report any damage, repairs needed or concerns as soon as possible, to any Officer or BOD member. File Incident Reports as required.
