

Fish House Fish & Game Club Trap Shooting Rules

Failure to follow any rule may result in disciplinary action, including suspension or expulsion from the club.

1. You must comply with all New York State firearm laws.
2. Shooting has hazards, use range at your own risk.
3. All shooters and spectators shall listen and respect all commands of the Shoot Officials / Range Safety Officers.
4. It is everyone's responsibility to report any unsafe shooting condition or action immediately to Shoot Officials / Range Safety Officers.
5. No alcohol or drugs allowed on range. No shooting when under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
6. No shooter 18 or younger may use the range facilities without adult supervision.
7. All pets should be on a leash, or secured, while shooting range is active. You must clean up after your pets.
8. No motor vehicles are allowed beyond the pavilion.
9. Shotguns only.
10. Firearms must be brought in unloaded.
11. All firearms when not in use shall be unloaded and actions open.
12. When carrying firearms to and from the rack, all muzzles must point away from any body part of a shooter, official or spectator at all times, whether or not the firearm is loaded.
13. Ear and eye protection must always be worn for firearm shooting, and for officials and spectators at any point past the end of the pavilion in the direction of the shooting stands. Ear protection is recommended for spectators in the pavilion.
14. No one is to be in front of the line of fire or in the target drop zone once shooters are at their shooting posts.
15. All shooting requires the shooter (except wheelchair shooters) to engage all targets from their post, in the standing position.
16. Shooters must have the permission of a Shoot Official / Range Safety Officer to test fire any firearm. Otherwise, firearms will be discharged only in attempt at clays.
17. In the event a shooter has a malfunctioning firearm, the remaining squad shall make their firearms safe, while the malfunction is being addressed.
18. Firearms must be shouldered for all shooting at targets.
19. Safety Zone – When a shooter is in the process of shooting, no one (other than a Shoot Official or Range Safety Officer) is allowed within three feet (3') of the shooter.

20. FHFGC rules prevail in all situations (such as shooting leagues or any competition matches).
21. Clean up and dispose of all trash in the proper receptacles.
22. Dispose of any "live rounds" in designated containers.
23. Report any damage, repairs needed or concerns as soon as possible, to any Officer or BOD member. File Incident Reports as required.
