



Request for Quote

Fish House Fish and Game Club (FHFGC) will be building a storage facility on its club site and is soliciting quotations for its construction. It will be pole barn construction with a concrete floor.

I. Location

FHFGC is located in the Town of Providence:

478 Fayville Road
Broadalbin, NY

The club location is a secure location with an electronic access security gate. The selected contractor will be given a temporary access card for construction purposes.

In the following, the **Seller** is the contractor selected to provide and construct the building and the **Buyer** is FHFGC.

II. Design Basis

The design basis is as follows:

1. The design is to be based on New York State and local building codes (Town of Providence).
2. The outside dimensions of the building is to be 32 feet wide (gable end) by 48 feet long.
3. The inside height of the building, from the top of the finished concrete floor to the bottom of the trusses, shall be 10 feet.
4. The roof pitch is 8/12 and the roof is to have 1 foot overhangs on each side and each end.
5. Steel roofing and siding with a minimum 20 year design life. Matching trim is to be included.
6. Each gable end is to include a centered, 10 by 9 foot steel, windowless, overhead door.
7. Each gable end is to also include a 3 by 8 foot steel, windowless, access door located to one side.
8. Imbedded poles will require concrete footings.

The Seller is to use FHFGC's Bill Domery's Fish House Fish and Game Club Pole Bar/Garage design drawings dated

III. Scope of Supply

The Buyer will provide a graded, compacted gravel filled site for Sellers construction.

The Buyer will provide an electronic access card for the Seller to access the site.



The Buyer will provide and install the building's electrical system.

The Buyer will obtain the building permit?

The Seller will be responsible for procuring all the material needed to erect the structure including beams, posts, engineered trusses, siding, roofing, concrete, supports, lumber, trim, and all related hardware required to construct the building.

In addition to his material/construction quote, if desired, the Seller can also provide an alternative quotation for construction only.

The Seller will provide the required worker compensation, disability, and liability forms required to obtain a building permit.

The Seller will be responsible for the procurement, and safe unloading, storing, and erection of his material. The Seller will provide the all the necessary tools, including, augers, lifting and support devices, needed to safely construct the building.

During preparation of the concrete floor, the Seller will install the Buyer's underground conduit for the electrical supply.

III. Schedule

The anticipated schedule is as follows:

Seller start construction	September 6, 2016 (Target)

IV. Information to be Included with Bid

The following minimum information is to be included with the Seller's bid:

1. The Seller needs to confirm that he is or is not using the Domery drawings as the basis of his design and scope of supply. Any deviations need to be identified.
2. The Seller needs to provide an experience list of similar size buildings that he has constructed.
3. The Seller needs to provide a materials list that lists major components and their description or vendor .
4. The price and payment schedule.
5. Estimated time to complete construction and availability to start construction.
